An Update on Refurbishment of Minninup Cottages

22 June 2023

A lot of work has been done at Minninup Cottages since we last updated you. At the moment, we are looking at the beginning of the fresh refurbishments, with all demolition nearly complete.

Part of these works was the completion of all external clearing. This uncovered numerous old storm pipes which were well beyond their used-by date, which have all been replaced and upgraded to a high standard. There has also been formwork fitted for the wider footpaths and gardens, with a major concrete pour scheduled to start in the coming week.


