General Competition Rules

- Games will be played on Thursday evenings with the season commencing Thursday 10 October.
- Registration forms are due by Monday 7 October.
- Players must be registered through a Team Nomination Form to play (see DRC staff if unsure).
- Fill-in players are allowed but must register their name on a fill-in sheet at the Centre kiosk.
- Any player that plays more than one-third of the fixtures must be on the Team Nomination form.
- A player must play one-third of the season's fixtures to be eligible to play in the finals.
- There is a one-off \$55.00 Team Nomination Fee which is due by the 3rd round.
- Each team is required to pay a weekly \$55.00 Fee Per Game. This must be paid in one (1) payment PRIOR to game commencement.
- The length and duration of the season will depend on the number of teams that register.
- **Forfeit rule:** a call must be made to the DRC in the event that a team has to forfeit. The following fees will be incurred in the event of late notice of forfeit.
 - → If the forfeit is made less than 24 hours prior to the game commencing, the forfeiting team will be obliged to pay half the cost of the game fee (\$27.50).
 - → If a team forfeits after 2:00pm on game day, the forfeiting team will be required to pay their full game fee (\$55.00).
 - → If a team gives no notice of forfeit and does not attend the game or is late they will be required to pay double the match fee (\$110.00).
- The Centre strongly recommends that you consult your doctor if you have any doubts whatsoever regarding your participation in any activities in the Centre.
- Should any injured person require first aid, it should be brought to the attention of a DRC staff member for assistance. The Centre staff will call emergency services if they deem it necessary. Injured parties will be liable for any costs that may result.
- Camera and video equipment are not to be used in the Centre unless prior written permission has been sought from the Centre Manager.
- Players and spectators are required to observe the gym and facility rules. All users must wear enclosed shoes and wear a shirt matching their team colours.
- All players must be a minimum of 14 years of age.

Mixed Netball Team Rules

- Teams can have a maximum of 7 players on the court at once and a minimum of 5. If a team has less than 5 players, the game will be forfeited.
- A maximum of 12 players can be registered onto a team nomination form.
- A maximum of 3 males from each team are permitted on the court at one time.
- A maximum of 1 male per team is permitted in a starting position in each third of court, i.e. 1 male GK or GD, 1 male
 C or WD or WA, 1 male GA or GS.
- Games will be played in four 10-minute quarters.
- 3 points will be awarded for a win, 1 point awarded for a draw, and no points for a loss.
- In the result of a team forfeiting a game, the opposition will receive a 10-0 win and 3 points.
- The referee's decision will be final, with the referee having the ability to remove players from the game if required.
- All users must wear enclosed non-marking shoes and wear a shirt matching their team colours.
- Please be respectful of other players and umpires at all times.
